Hrvoje Njirić

Hrvoje Njirić was born in Zagreb, Croatia and studied in Architecture at the Architectural Faculty, University of Zagreb.

njiric+ arhitekti was founded by Hrvoje Njiric in 2001 and is based in Zagreb, Croatia. Hrvoje Njiric gained acknowledgement in the 90's with projects developed by the former njiric+njiric partnership. The schemes for European (3 first prizes) and Slovenian projects for Baumaxx and McDonald's were widely published and awarded.

Hrvoje Njiric is engaged in teaching since the mid 90's. He was visiting professor at the TU Graz, Austria (1998-1999), the AF Ljubljana, Slovenia (2000), the Facolta di Architettura, Ferrara, Italy (2000).

Between 2000 until 2005 Hrvoje Njirić served as a full-time professor and head of the Institute for Architectural Typologies and Housing at the TU Graz (successor of Guenther Domenig) and visiting professor at the University of Toronto, Daniels School of Architecture (The Frank Gehry Chair recipient for 2012), Canada, guest professor at the MIT Boston, USA "The Jacquelin T. Robertson Visiting Professor", University of Virginia, USA.

The work of prof. Njirić practice has been extensively published in national and international press, recently in numerous architectural websites as well. The 90's projects have been a subject of the monograph by the EI Croquis #114 - „metabalcanico“. A recent monograph of the practice for the period 2000-2010 is the 2G, published 2011 in Spain.

Currently, Hrvoje Njirić is full professor at Faculty of civil engineering, architecture and geodesy, University of Split.
