

## ASPHER 2014 Deans' and Directors' Retreat in Zagreb, May 28-31, 2014

### WORKING TOGETHER: TOWARDS A SUFFICIENT AND COMPETENT PUBLIC HEALTH WORKFORCE

#### Purpose of the Retreat:

The main purpose of the high level meeting of heads of ASPHER member institutions is to evaluate previous year's activities, together with planning and organising the future direction of ASPHER. This year it will start with the General Assembly on May 28 in the afternoon. Besides standard activities, General Assembly will open the process of consultation on development of ASPHER 2020 Strategy. The second part of the Retreat will follow with an intensive working meeting on the role of ASPHER community and partners within EPHOs (during May 29 and 30).

#### Participants:

Deans and directors – heads of ASPHER member institutions, invited speakers, representatives of ASPHER partner organisations, members of ASPHER Honours' Committee, and members of ASPHER Executive Board.

#### Outcome:

The main outcome of the Retreat will be oriented towards active involvement of deans and directors in development of ASPHER 2020 Strategy and in all activities dedicated to strong development of EPHOs reflecting European education, practice and research for public health. It is expected that this year's Retreat will result in ASPHER policy briefs to support further development of EPHOs based on ASPHER mandate in EPHO7.
