MALAYSIAN TECHNICAL COOPERATION program MTCP was officially launched on 7 September 1980 at the Commonwealth Heads of State Meeting in New Delhi to signify Malaysia's commitment to South-South Cooperation, in particular to share its development experiences and expertise with other developing countries. Based on the belief that the development of a country depends on the quality of its human resources, MTCP emphasizes the development of human resources through the provision of training in various areas which are essential for a country's development such as public administration, good governance, health services, education, sustainable development, agriculture, poverty alleviation, investment promotion, ICT and banking. More than 100 short-term specialized courses are offered by more than 50 MTCP training institutions, many of which are centres of excellence for training. Since its launching, more than 25,000 participants from 140 countries have benefited from the various program offered under the MTCP.

OBJECTIVES OF MTCP

- To share development experience with other countries;
- To strengthen bilateral relations between Malaysia and other developing countries;
- To promote South-South Cooperation (SSC); and
- To promote technical cooperation among developing countries (TCDC).

Training on Non Destructive Testing & Evaluation, Ultrasonic Testing Level 1

This course to assist in preparing the participants to take the NDT Ultrasonic level 1 Certification and Qualification examination in accordance to ISO 9712. The course is intended to provide thorough knowledge in the principles of Ultrasonic Testing and fundamentals of materials and processes such that the trainee would be able to identify suitability of UT for the material and inspection techniques, develop techniques and procedures, analyze the test results and document the same and are familiar with codes, standards and specifications.

Objectives Training

- To enhance the knowledge of participants in understanding the NDT principles and its applications.
- To certify professional NDT to Ultrasonic Level 1 in accordance to ISO 9712: 2012 Non-destructive testing - Qualification and certification of NDT personnel.

Course Content

Ultrasonic Testing Level 1

Introduction to Ultrasonic Testing, Terminology, Physical Principle and fundamental of Ultrasonic, Generation and detection, Instrumentation, Testing Technique, Calibration of testing System, Casting forging and rolling, Testing technique considering of test specimen, Testing technique considering code and standards, Conducting and recording the test, Evaluation of test result.

Course Methodology

Lectures, workshop, case study and group discussion will be conducted in between the session and Industrial Visit.

Criteria of Applicant

The candidate must have a combination of qualifying educational and minimum working experience of three years. The person should have a technical or scientific background in the area of engineering / physical sciences. The candidate shall satisfy the requirements for vision as defined in ISO 9712.

HOW TO APPLY

Application must be made using the standard application form and submitted through the applicant's government to the official representatives of the Malaysian Embassy / Malaysian Focal Point. Submitted application form must be accompanied by the applicant's :

Applicants will be notified of their acceptance to the course either through the Malaysian Embassies, Malaysian Focal Point or SIRIM.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Visa and Vaccination

All participants are required to enter Malaysia with Visa with Reference (VDR). Once the approval is obtained, the training institutions should send a copy of letter of approval to the participants. Subsequently, with the copy of the approval, the participants may get the VDR from the nearest Malaysian Missions. Wherever applicable, participants are advised to arrange on their own for vaccination prior to travel to Malaysia

Expenditures on all visa-related fees, airport tax/airport user's charge, transit insurance, excess luggage, travel tax, transit fees, domestic passenger terminal fees, phone charges, private purchases, etc. are borne by the recipients. It also applies for vaccination before travel to Malaysia.

Course Fee

All course fees are borne by the Government of Malaysia.

Accommodation and Meals

Accommodation and food are provided. Participants are not allowed to change any arrangement done by the respective training institution.

Fares

A return air ticket from the capital city of the recipient country to Kuala Lumpur on economy class is provided for participants from countries which their GDP per capita is below USD5,000. However, some countries need to bear their own air fares.

Medical Treatment

Candidates should be certified medically and physically fit to participate in this program. In the case of emergencies and in need of medical treatment, the medical expenses in a government hospital will be borne by the Government of Malaysia. In case of admission in government hospitals, participants will be eligible for first class wards (two bedded or more). However in private clinic or Medical Centre the medical expenses is on participant's own liability.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF AWARD

Participants shall conduct themselves at all times in a manner compatible with their responsibilities as MTCP scholarship holders and abide by the laws, rules and regulations of SIRIM.

Participants are NOT allowed to bring along their spouses or families for the duration of the course. Participants are NOT allowed to leave Malaysia during the course.

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Participants shall abide by the terms and conditions of the MTCP.

The global beauty care industry is estimated to reach around USD 265 billion in 2017. Increasing consumer preferences towards natural, herbal based and HALAL cosmetic products is forcing the cosmetic and toiletries manufacturers to change strategies to meet customer demands.

As the leading country in Halal certification, Malaysia has produced several Halal Standard encompassing

logistic, transportation, food, cosmetic and pharmaceutical products. These Standards serves as guideline to manufacturer to produce and market halal products in compliance with Halal requirements.

The course is designed to provide the participants an understanding and meeting the basic concepts of HALAL requirements of MS 2200:Part 1:2008.

The OBJECTIVE of this training is to train up participants as SIRIM GREEN 5-S Auditor (5-S and L5S) for improving the safety, health, quality, productivity, image, cost, environment and speed through the proprietary SIRIM-Green 5S Practice.

Course Content

Participants will be exposed with the quantitative as well as qualitative tools and techniques of SIRIM GREEN 5-S. Participants will also be made aware of the necessary elements and social tools needed to support a SIRIM GREEN 5-S culture. This knowledge should be able to help participants in developing their own model of SIRIM GREEN 5-S to be implemented in their own countries.

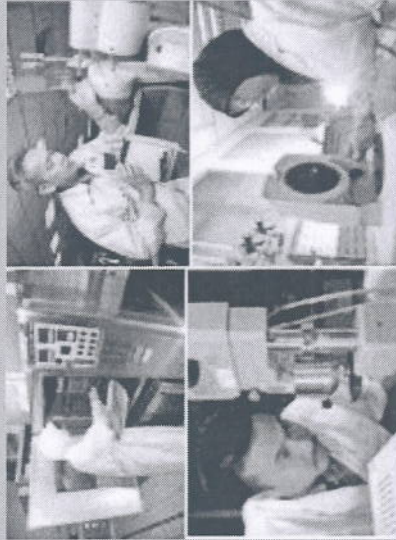

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OBJECTIVES OF MTCP

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TRAINING ON INJECTION MOLDING PROCESS WITH ANALYSIS AND TESTING AND CHARACTERIZATION OF PLASTICS MATERIALS

The training basically includes one common type of plastics processing which is injection molding. It will be focusing on the basics of injection molding operation. Mold flow analysis is one of present common practice to learn or evaluate flow properties in a mold prior to mold making/fabricating or in the production and requiring improvement or adjustment.

Objectives Training

- The part of training that covers injection molding and mold flow analysis will serve as an excellent refresher course for any employee, from operators and technicians to management and setup personnel.
- The remaining part of the training will serve as a knowledge to understanding the type of plastics material available nowadays and how plastics material are evaluate through types of testing and characterization.
- The objective of the whole training will basically covers the processing side as well as evaluation of the plastics material.

Course Content

Participants will be focusing on the types of plastics material available today and its properties. Various types of testing and characterization of plastics material with demonstration to display the common practice of plastics evaluation .

Course Methodology

Lectures, workshop, case study and group discussion will be conducted in between the session and Industrial Visit.

Criteria of Applicant

- Management of Plastics Manufacturers, Quality related staff, Plastics industries vendor development, Production staff.
- Age between 25 – 45 years old
- Preferred background in Engineering or Materials
